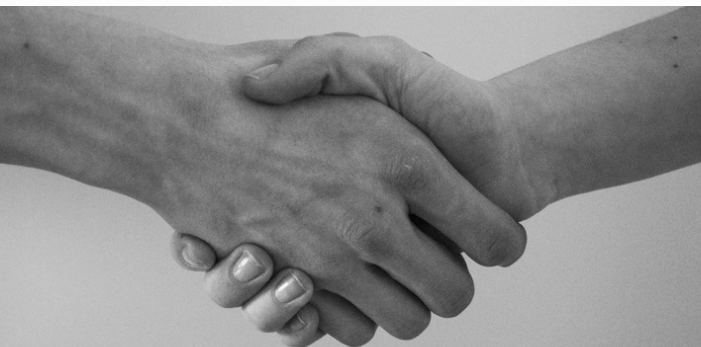


## How we can support people in the HHSP program?

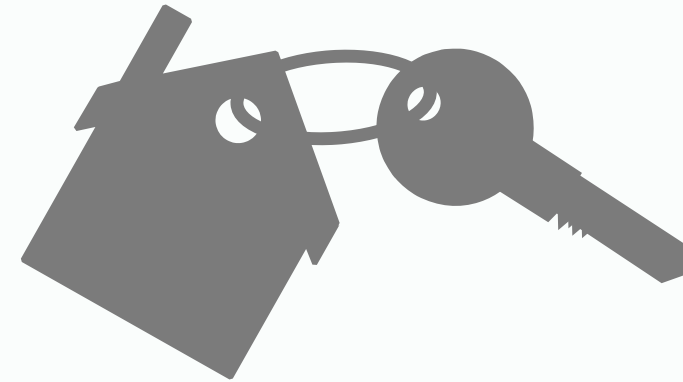
